

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – 6 SEPTEMBER 2019

We are commencing the program of work on the Central Avenue East upgrades. As part of this process, we are replacing the median strips, garden beds and tree pits. We will also be re-asphalting the road surface. This work will carry out over the next 6 months.

The first phase of this starts at the Garden Street end and we will work out way down the street towards the Davy Road intersection.

As you would know we have one-way traffic down Central Avenue during work hours. This will now be in effect full time - whilst we complete these works. To exit the site from Central Avenue you will need to use Davy Road.

More work in the area is to the trees along Mitchell Way. These have been identified as being on the noxious weeds list. We have decided to remove them and replace with native trees.

What to expect:

Water filled barriers with fencing will be placed in the work zone. This is the first phase. I will send another update as we progress along the street.

One-way traffic at all times along Central Avenue East, from Garden Street to Davy Road intersection.

Work duration:

This work on Central Avenue will commence next week, Monday 9th September.

The tree removal will take place this weekend. The replacement trees will be available in approx. 6 weeks.
